### A COWMAN'S KIND OF MATERNAL GENETICS

The goal of our breed and selection program is to produce cattle that utilize strictly grass and grass hay. Additionally, we strive to produce cows who annually wean a calf that is half of momma's weight at 205 days of age without creep feed. Osage April, pictured above, is a visual example of the type of idealized cow we strive for. Medium frame (body weight - 1100 pounds), body condition 5 to 6 year around, near-perfect udder, calm disposition, and production longevity are what April embodies. This cow is 15 years old and has produced 13 calves to date. The average birth weight of five bull progeny is 84 lbs, and their average 205 day weight is 607 pounds. The average birth weight of April's eight female progeny is 75 lbs and their average 205 day weaning weight is 510 lbs. Calf number 14 is due this coming April. If grass genetics and reliable production longevity are part of your program goals, please give our genetics your consideration.

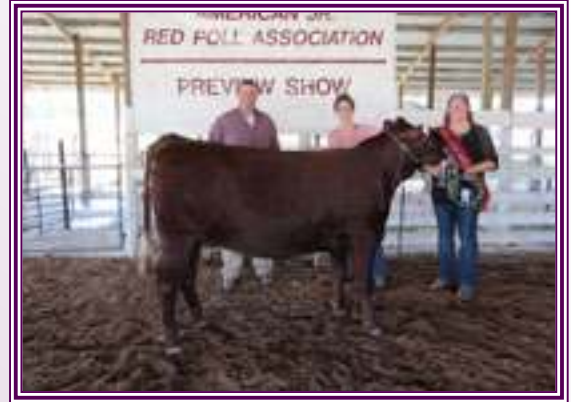

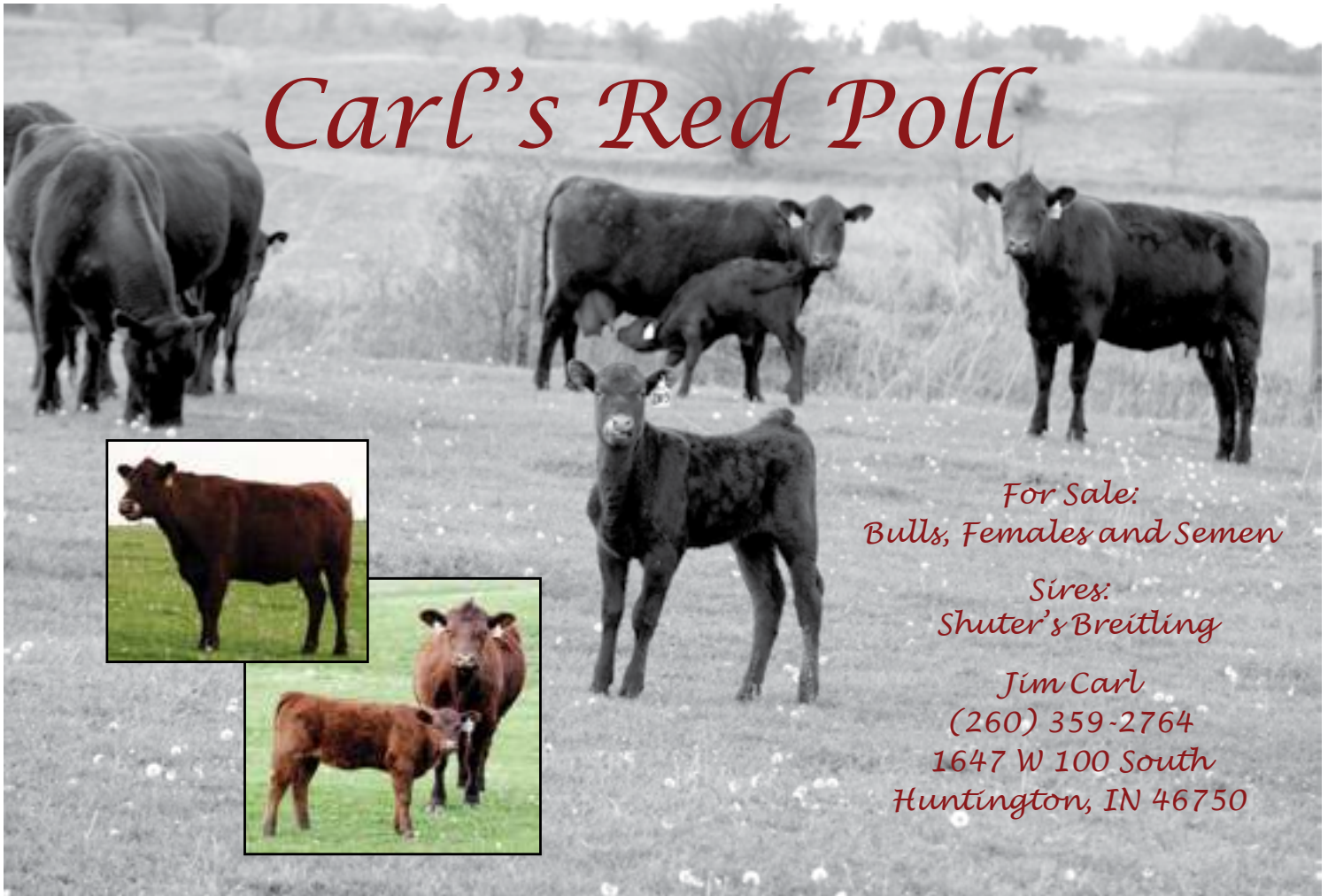

## Proposed Bylaw Changes

We propose to **ADD** the following section, which will then adjust subsequent sections by a letter:

### **M. Registration Classification**

1. Fullblood is 100% Red Poll. (no mixing of another breed or commercial animal)
2. Appendix Registered (AR) is a registered animal with 1/4 or greater American Red Poll blood mixed with another breed or commercial animal. These will be permanently identified on the registration paper as Appendix Registered (AR) cattle.

We propose to **REVISE** the following sections (please note that some sections have a new letter due to the added section above):

### SUBSECTION N(formerly M), 2

*Currently reads:* An animal, embryo and/or semen imported from any country whose progenitors trace on both sire's and dam to up-graded stock shall carry an asterisk (\*) in front of the Herd Book Registration Number, to be entered in the American Red Poll Association Appendix Registry Herd Book.

*Proposed Change:* An animal, embryo and/or semen imported from any country whose progenitors trace on either sire's and dam to up-graded stock shall carry a prefix of AR in front of the Herd Book Registration Number, to be entered in the American Red Poll Association Appendix Registry Herd Book.

### SUBSECTION O (formerly N), 1A

*Currently reads:* As of January 1, 1986 initial entries of 3/8 Red Poll blood concentration level or higher will be accepted into the Appendix Registry Program.

*Proposed Change:* As of January 1, 1986 initial entries of 1/4 Red Poll blood concentration level or higher will be accepted into the Appendix Registry Program.

### SUBSECTION O(formerly N), 2A

*Currently reads:* Must be inspected by the Field man of the American Red Poll Association.

*Proposed Change:* Must be inspected by a representative of the Board of Directors.

### SUBSECTION O(formerly N), 2B

*Currently reads:* Must show indications of purebred Red Poll characteristics, accordingly using the Record Standardization description.

*Proposed Change:* Must show indications of purebred Red Poll characteristics.

### SUBSECTION O(formerly N), 2E

*Proposed Addition:* Females at this level will be registered at the 5/8 level.

### SUBSECTION O(formerly N), 5-8

*Proposed Deletion:* Eliminate items 5, 6, 7, and 8.

### SUBSECTION P (formerly O)

*Currently reads:* Categories of Appendix Registry (AR and FBA).

*Proposed Change:* Categories of Appendix Registry.

### SUBSECTION P(formerly O), 1

*Currently reads:* AR (Appendix Registry) shall be the prefix to the registration number assigned to the cattle of 3/8, 7/16, 1/2, 9/16, 5/8, 11/16, 3/4, 13/16 and 7/8 blood concentration levels.

*Proposed Change:* AR (Appendix Registry) shall be the prefix to the registration number and the blood concentration shall be listed on the registration certificate.

### SUBSECTION P(formerly O), 4

*Proposed Deletion:* Eliminate entire number.

### SUBSECTION R(formerly P), 2

*Currently reads:* All Appendix Registered animals will be eligible to sell at the National Sale. The National Show will be segregated into AR/FBA and full-blood cattle. All Artificial Insemination rules regulating the registry of progeny conceived through Artificial Insemination in the ARPA Herd Book shall also apply to all cattle in the Appendix Registry Program. Non-typical blood types are acceptable on Appendix Registry bulls.

*Proposed Change:* All Appendix Registered animals will be eligible to sell at the National Sale. All Artificial Insemination rules regulating the registry of progeny conceived through Artificial Insemination in the ARPA Herd Book shall also apply to all cattle in the Appendix Registry Program.

### SUBSECTION R(formerly P), 3

*Currently reads:* All Appendix Registry cattle shall carry an asterisk (\*) in front of their registration number. This will be permanent and will appear on the pedigree of all progeny of Appendix registered parents

*Proposed Change:* All Appendix Registry cattle shall carry an AR in front of their registration number. This will be permanent and will appear on the pedigree of all progeny of Appendix registered parents.

# World Tour 2018 Possibilities

The following letter was received from Bob Hays with regards to the 2018 World Tour.

Mark your calendars now for an exciting time in South America.

Dear Red Poll friends,

I have floated this idea with some of you unofficially prior to putting it to Council next year in USA and you have asked me for my ideas so here goes! Officially the 2020 slot for a Conference is South America but I will be 80 and probably gaga by that time if I'm still in this world. So something informal I think fairly soon? It will be my swan song and I'd like to do it. Frankly, I can't see anyone else doing a tour in this neck of the woods in the foreseeable future for RPs.

I learnt a lot from the tour we did in 2000. We tried to do too much and with five frontier crossings and different hotels almost every night and 85 overseas visitors it was a bit too stressful for all concerned. So the idea this time will be a bit more laid back. Obviously, the prime objective will be to look at cattle but as always there would be a 40% tourism built in. If anyone has any ideas for other arable interests we can take that in too, given time. Costs will be kept reasonable- no five star hotels but comfortable.

Bus travel would be a 45 seater coach with seating equivalent to aircraft business class. Some travel is inevitable considering the distances involved but I would try and stay in each hub for about four days in the same hotel. So when? Idea is either March or October 2018. Cattle here are not at their best in October as we are coming into spring after winter and it's calving time. For northern hemisphere it's their preference but? Your ideas please!

Genetically, we haven't got much to offer you but on the contrary South America is an opportunity to sell yours. Nevertheless, I hope to visit at least one world class Angus herd in Uruguay on the tour. It's early days yet but I have more or less got a provisional team together to make your trip as interesting and memorable as possible with the maximum interchange of ideas between the participants.

Here is a provisional itinerary of 16 days. Start at Florianopolis Brazil. There are good connections through Sao Paulo to Africa, USA and Europe though Oz and NZ folk might like to break their flights direct from there to Chile for a day or two in Santiago, (can be arranged). The first day would be on a beach to get rid of the jet lag with a show in the evening. Next look at a couple of RP or other cattle herds in the area. Bus to Gramado up in the Serra gaucha, very pretty, google it if you like. Then work south to the Porto Alegre area. Rather depends on our Brazilian friends on this leg. Then to Uruguay, based in my town of Tacuarembó and bus it out to various farms from there each day. One of the ideas I have is that if you ain't been to gaucha country and haven't been on a horse... so thinking arranging about twenty saddled quiet horses for an hours ride around a typical Uruguayan estancia. For those who don't wish to eat their breakfast of the mantelpiece next morning SUVs would be laid on or a shopping trip for those not interested to Rivera.

From Tacuarembó there would be an overnight trip up to Iguazu Falls on the triple frontier Paraguay/Argentina/Brazil. One of the wonders of the world and lots to see and do for two or three days. Highly recommended and it won't be too hot. Plenty of connecting flight home from either of the two airports but if you want to prolong your stay elsewhere in South America I can arrange through our travel agent. You should arrange health cover in case of accidents and check on what visas if any you need for Brazil, Argentina and Uruguay.

Lots of ideas more but let me have your own ideas so let me know if you have any preferences of what you would like to see and do and I will try and tailor them in. Talk soon on skype once you have digested this sketch plan. Places would be limited to one bus load.

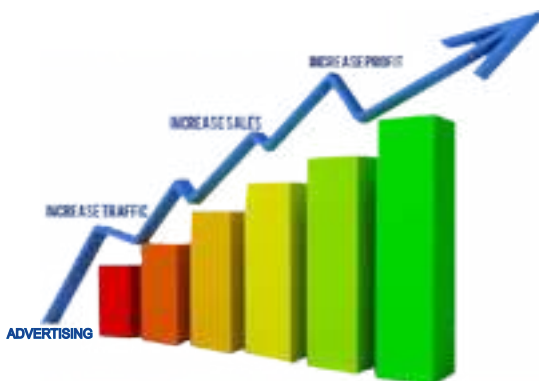

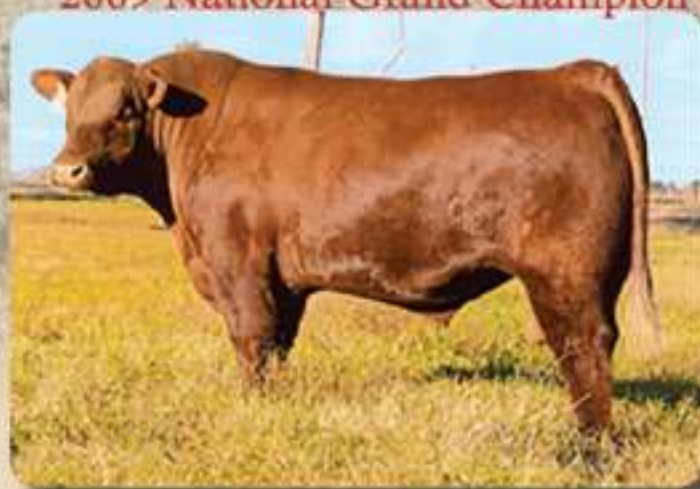
