Faron seconded the motion. Phil turned down the request. So Kyle amended the motion to have Chet Miller and Mike Reed on the committee. Motion passed.

JL talked about the Lap Top Raffle for raising money for the National Show. He paid \$546.00 for the computer and had raised \$450.00 so far. Ticket to be drawn during the show. He asked the Board to donate money to cover the difference.

Junior Committee Report: Teresa noted the juniors are still looking for someone to host the Junior Preview Show.

Nominating Committee has nominated JL Morrison, John Rager and Greg Fairchild to run for the 3 spots on the Board. Kyle Young and Dan Womelsdorf are going off the Board.
