From the President

First and foremost, I pray that our cattle members are doing well. But, what a year in the cattle industry! From what I have been reading cattle prices are to remain strong until 2020. It's great if you have cattle to sell, could be bad if you are just starting out in the cattle world. But, I think even with higher prices people

need to look at the cattle they are going to purchase as investments into the future of your operation. I feel a lot of people made investments into the future of their herds by purchasing great animals at the National Sale in Sedalia, MO this past fall. Results were: 16 Open Heifers averaged \$2556 with lot 23 being the top at \$4100, 2 Bred heifers averaged 2900 with Lot 2 the top at \$3000, 2 Cows averaged \$3450 with the lot 10 cow-calf pair selling for \$5000, and 7 Bulls averaged \$2614 with lot 31 the top at \$5000. Our association had a great turn out, it's great to see our association growing with new participating people. As for this next year there is no site location selected for our 2015 National Sale as of yet, so any ideas are appreciated by contacting me or a board member.

I always get a renewed energized feeling as springtime is just about upon us. This is a season that I always look forward to, our decisions that we made last year to breed what bull with what cow will soon show up. My anticipation of what my calves will look like, what it will grow into, what traits did it get from its mother or father are things I think about continually. Birth weight is important, but there is more involved than just having a good birth weight calf; good udders, strong maternal traits are things that we also want. But, sometimes our choices in breeding do not always turn out for the better, but we should be continually learning. We as breeders have a responsibility to always try to improve our breed for our customers as well as ourselves.

Thank you to the new members that have joined us in the association the past year and to the continued support of our current members. I hope our association continues to excel with new members as well as new interest in our breed from other cattle people. Don't forget about the 2017 World Red Poll Congress that ARPA will be hosting. 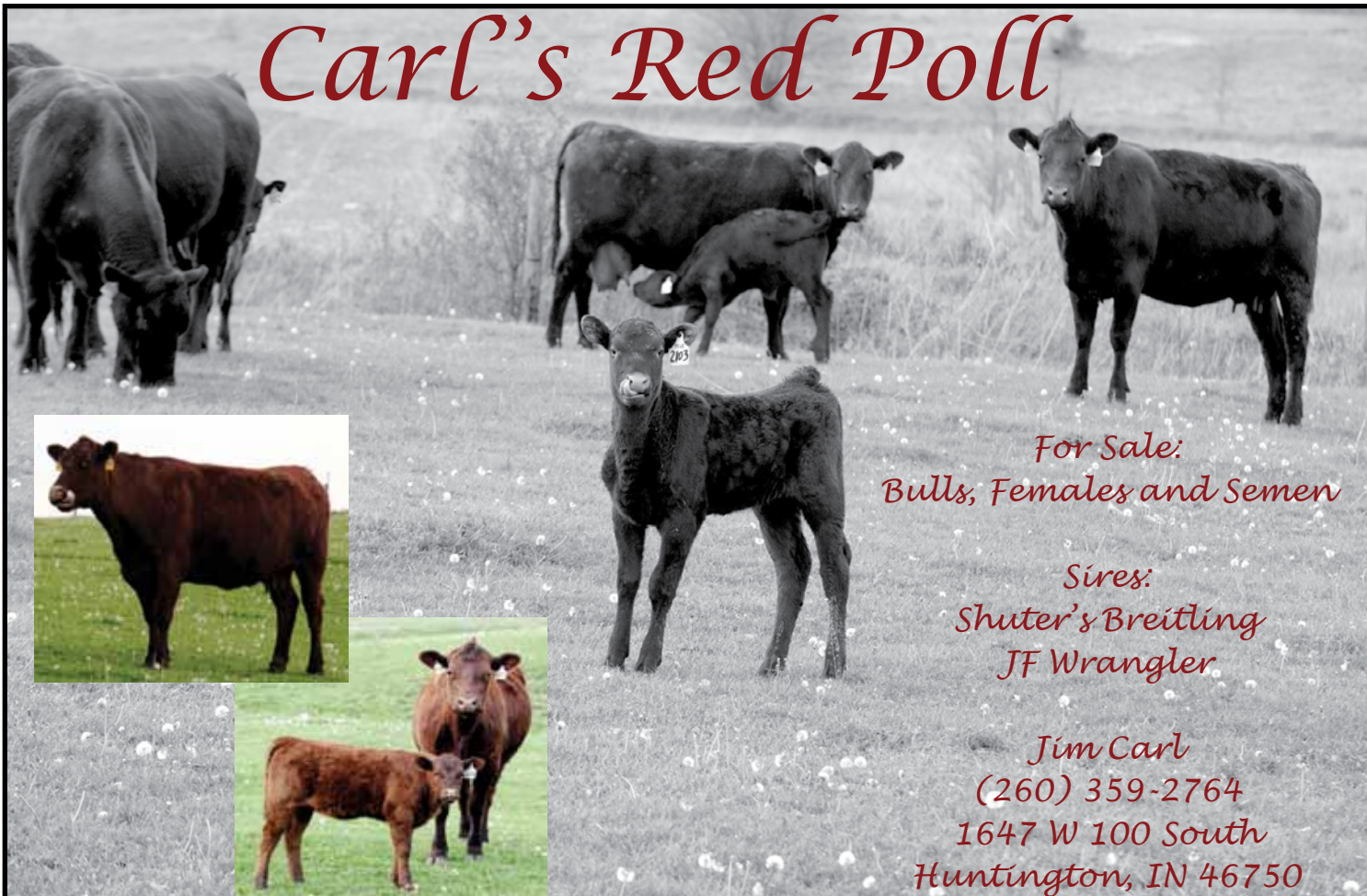

14th Red Poll World Congress Conference Delegates Meeting

Monday, November 3, 2014

1. Welcome:

Richard Daley, The Australian Red Poll Cattle Breeders Inc. Federal president welcomed the delegates from Australia, New Zealand, Kenya, Jamaica, USA, Canada, and England.

2. Apologies: Nil

3. Vale and respect for our lost tour members since last tour.

Delegates from each country in turn gave a vale for Members and tour members who had passed away since the last tour and conference.

4. Correspondence:

A letter from Phyllis Hunt, formerly of the Waroona Vale Red Poll Stud, wishing everyone best wishes on the tour and conference was tabled.

5. Delegates Reports:

A. KENYA:

Jimmy Brooks and Erick Otieno Owino spoke on the livestock production systems and breed types used in the beef and dairy industries in Kenya. A slide show was used to illustrate the populated areas of the country and potential areas suitable for agricultural production. The many challenges and opportunities in all farming pursuits in Kenya were covered. The one Red Poll breeder in Kenya believes that the breed's future in his country is as a dairy breed and for crossing with Boran cattle also used as dairy cattle. Semen has been imported from South Africa, England and Australia over the years to bring in new genetics to Kenya.

B. ENGLAND:

Terry Mancey reported that market volatility is evident in England as is experienced around the world. Registrations of Red Poll cattle in England are fairly constant with 400 members in the society. It was reported that the Castlefields herd is being sold. The Society is providing assistance to members in performance recording and semen collection. Slides of bulls that have had semen collected were shown. The society has a new website, a new logo and a new brochure. It was reported that the future looks bright.

C. NEW ZEALAND:

Graeme Evens reported that there are 22 active members currently in New Zealand. Many of these breeders have herds of less than 20 breeding cows. There are currently 2 or 3 breeders using A.I. or embryo transfer in their herds. There are a small number of breeders showing cattle at agricultural shows. The longevity of the breed is one trait that is currently being focused on. It was reported that the high cost of land in New Zealand is a barrier prohibiting younger breeders from getting established.

D. CANADA:

Dean Anderson reported that numbers of Red Poll breeders are low with one breeder in Western Canada and two or three breeders in other parts of the country. Semen is being imported in an attempt to try and re-establish the breed.

E. JAMAICA:

Martin Hopwood reported that agriculture in Jamaica accounts for approximately 1% of GDP and is well down the list in industries receiving government support. The tropically adapted Red Poll is the most popular breed of cattle in Jamaica. It was reported that some breeders are conducting A.I. programs but the majority of producers use natural mating in their herds. Cattle prices are currently good for all classes of cattle and plans are for existing members to increase numbers of breeders in their herds, and to increase membership. The Alcan herd is planned to be reduced in numbers. All delegates and members stood to applaud Karl Wellington congratulating him on receiving the Order of Jamaica.

F. USA:

Dan Schmiesing, firstly reported that this tour was the first Red Poll tour that a member of the McKee family has not attended. He also reported that registration numbers are fairly stable. The Red Poll breed is considered a heritage breed in the United States. Many small landholders show an interest in breeding cattle from a heritage breed. The breed has a plan to increase the number of herds involved with performance recording. Some of the challenges facing the breed are fewer large herds, with many herds having 10-20 breeders and low EPD accuracies. Dan would like to get a worldwide EPD up and running. The next generation of leaders are required to lead the breed into the future. Dan's thoughts are that the Myostatin gene can be worked with. It was reported that some research into salmonella resistance in red cattle is showing promise although this research is in its early stages.

6. Australian youth group presentation:

Rachael Hancock gave a presentation on Facebook and how it can help to promote the breed. Many studs are using Facebook to promote their stud. Facebook has over 1 billion users worldwide and news and information can be sent and received by a large number of people around the world.

7. Next Congress USA:

It is proposed that the next Congress and tour will take place between the end of June and the start of August in 2017. Dan Schmiesing gave a brief outline of where the tour would be traveling and some of the proposed places the tour could visit. Any ideas for a theme would be appreciated.

8. Nominations of host country following USA:

Following much discussion it was moved by Graeme Evans and seconded by Jill Brockman that correspondence be sent to Uruguay inviting them to host the 2020 conference and tour. If Uruguay declines, then South Africa be asked if they would be prepared to host the conference and tour. If South Africa is not prepared to be the host country then New Zealand will be the host country for the 2020 Red Poll Conference and tour. Carried

9. General Business:

- Exchange of genetic material across international borders
- The Myostatin gene in Red Poll cattle.
The MT 821 gene mutation found in the Red Poll breed was discussed and the results of research into the effect that the gene has on different breeds of cattle was tabled. The UK society carries out a bull inspection and a hair sample is taken to identify how many copies of the gene the bull has. This appears on his pedigree. It has been left up to the breeder to decide what to do with the animals carrying the gene. The New Zealand president wanted to see it removed from the stud herds. The probability of early embryonic deaths was suggested as a reason that we do not see offspring with two copies of the gene as often as we might expect.
- Formalizing a World Red Poll Body
Letter that was drafted some years ago as a guideline to the formation of a World Red Poll body was tabled and whilst it was agreed that a copy of the letter be given to each National president, no further action was taken.
- Other: Working together.
A suggestion was put forward regarding having EBVs across countries. Some of the benefits were discussed and some of the difficulties in making this happen were put forward.

10. Adjournment:

Australian Federal president closed the meeting a 5:10 pm and thanked everyone for their contribution.

70th National Red Poll Sale

Summary Sedalia, MO

The 70th National Red Poll Sale was one for the record books. The Western States Red Poll Association, once again, hosted a great sale and banquet. The weekend provided many of our Red Poll friends to share and enjoy talking about family and our cattle business. Thank you to all who made this event so successful.

After a short delay, while the auctioneer made his way to the event, a large crowd gathered and bid vigorously on the great set of cattle on offer. There were many new breeders and local cattlemen in attendance, many looking to buy their first Red Polls and to join in on this growing breed.

The Sale topper in the bull division was easily, Parkstyle Rocky Scotty. This September 2013 son of Parkstyle Rocky and a cow from the powerful Parkstyle Linda cow family found many friends. This powerful herdsire prospect from Mike Parks and Family will headline the bull battery for the new Womelsdorf Red Poll herd of Dan and Rene Womelsdorf in Kansas. It took \$5000 for Dan and Rene to get him on their trailer that day. Other top bulls included Shuter's Amazon, a February 2013 bull consigned by Shuter Sunset Farms, selling to Gail Spegal and Family for \$3000, and WBH Omar L325 a November 2013 bull consigned by Wiese Farms, selling to Larry Creech for \$2900. Eight bulls sold for an average of \$2287.

The top female lot was a cow-calf pair consigned by Shuter Sunset Farms. The cow was a 2005 model cow that originated in the Nine West Oak Canyon herd. Her powerful May bull calf sired by Shuter's Fuzz and the fact that she was bred back the same way enticed Jeff Doll and Doll's Red Polls to bid \$2500 a piece, giving the pair a \$5000 valuation. The lone other cow in the sale was a 2011 born cow, originating in the Simpson Calhoun herd and consigned by Good Life Ranch and Geoff McPherson and was purchased for \$1900 by Dan and Rene Womelsdorf.

Womelsdorf swept the bred heifer offering to add to his growing herd in Kansas. Both the bred heifer offerings came from Stieber's Red Polls. Jackie's heifers were multiple generation Stieber breeding on the bottom side of the pedigree and were bred to his powerful herdsire, WBH Rocky BR123, whom he purchased from Wiese Farms. The bred heifers brought \$2800 and \$3000 respectively to the volume buyers of the sale. The Womelsdorf Family is putting together quite a set of cows from across the country.

The bidding was very active on the open heifers. Robert Carson added another foundation animal to his growing herd in North Carolina with his purchase of the high selling open heifer, a January 2014 heifer calf consigned by Hill Top Farm. John Rager's calf was a Shuter's Thunderstruck out of his established Starletta cow family. She should mate well with Robert's high selling herdsire from Jackson Farms in last year's sale. Donald Fast grabbed the next two high selling heifer calves from Wiese Farms. Both of Bill and Brian's heifers were November 2014 heifers, sired by GS Bellringer and tracing to Jill's Daffie GR24, one of their great, proven cow lines. The Jackson Farms crew was involved in the other three notable open heifer's selling. They bid \$2900 to own one of the other Hill Top Farms offerings and their two open heifers sold for \$2800 and \$2600, selling to Larry Earls and Greg and Brian Fairchild, respectively. In total, 16 open heifers averaged \$2568.

Overall, the 2014 National Red Poll Sale was quite a success. Many new breeders were able to get involved and add new genetics to their herds. Some of the newest members of the Association came out and made quite a statement about where they think the future of the breed is headed. It's been a long time coming but maybe the word is starting to get out about how much this great breed of cattle has to offer the beef industry.
