<u>National Meeting and Sale:</u> The cattle will be located at the fairgrounds. Cattle may arrive from Noon until 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 21.

<u>Consignors:</u> Dr. Jeff Wilkins will be available Thursday from Noon-5:00 p.m. in the barn. You must have Dr. Wilkins check health papers and ID <u>before unloading</u>. Without proper papers, you will **not** be allowed to unload the cattle. The consignor is responsible to arrange health certification for interstate shipment: inform your veterinarian of sale location and time. The consignments should be certified to go to any buyer in any state. Please provide one health paper per lot.

Bags of bedding will be available at cost for purchased at the fairgrounds.

<u>PLEASE NOTE: Un-haltered Cattle:</u> In order to accommodate un-haltered cattle, we need to know the exact number of pens you will need. Each pen will be 10'x12'. We will be renting gates to accommodate un-haltered cattle. There will be sufficient tie spaces for haltered cattle.

<u>National Meeting:</u> Registration will begin at 8:30 a.m. Friday in the Sheep Barn. You must register and have paid your annual service fee to be a member in good standing and to have voting privileges. Please fill out the lunch number so we will have an accurate count. We are looking for a lunch sponsor (s) so the meal will be free to those attending. Reservations are **due September 15.**

Follow I-70 to US-35 N. Take exit 149B to the north from I-70 at the Love's Truck Center. After \sim 0.8 mile, turn left onto Salisbury Rd. Go south \sim 2.7 mile and turn left into fairgrounds.

FROM THE EAST VIA US 40:



Follow US-40 W, go through Richmond about 5 miles. Turn right (north) onto Salisbury Rd. After 1.1 mile, turn right into fairgrounds.



FROM THE WEST VIA US 40:

Follow US-40 E, go through Centerville past the McDonald's at the stop light

turn left (north) onto Salisbury Rd. After 1.1 mile, turn right into fairgrounds.
