#### **General Information**

<u>Date, Time, and Place</u>: Friday, March 1st, and Saturday, March 2nd, 2024. Show 2:30 P.M. FRIDAY SALE 9:30 A.M. SATURDAY.

**Terms:** Terms of the sale are cash unless other arrangements are made with the individual owner before the sale. The auctioneer will settle any disputes as to bids. Each animal will be sold to the highest bidder without reservation and will be at the purchaser's risk as soon as sold and can be moved after settlement is made.

**Registration Certificates:** The cattle are registered in the Herd Book of the American Red Poll Association. Certificates of registration will be furnished, with transfers recorded, free of extra cost to buyers.

**Health Papers:** Cattle, except official vaccinates that are under age, will have a 30-day negative test for TB and Brucellois, except for cattle from Certified and Accredited herds. It is advisable to know your own state's health requirements on bringing cattle in from out of state. Some states require permits.

**Consignor's Responsibility:** The seller is the responsible party for all representations made about his cattle. The management of the sale assumes no liability, legal or otherwise, but will endeavor to protect the interest of both the buyer and seller.

<u>Guarantee</u>: This sale will be conducted under the Red Poll Breeding Guarantee.

**Liability:** The Kentucky Red Poll Association, American Red Poll Association, Kentucky Department of Agriculture and Kentucky Beef Expo act as sale agents only for the consignors of this sale and assume no liability as to accidents to or by any animal. The guarantees given above are made by each consignor for his own animals which are selling.

<u>Transportation</u>: Transportation will be available. Check with clerk at time of settlement.

**Announcements:** Announcements made from the auction block take precedence over information printed in the catalog.

Welcome to the 38th Annual Kentucky Farm Bureau Beef Expo! As the largest beef cattle state east of the Mississippi River, Kentucky is blessed to have this event as a staple on our agriculture calendar each year.

Economists from the University of Kentucky anticipate agricultural receipts for 2023 could be \$8.1 billion, just shy of 2022's record-high \$8.3 billion.

These numbers show how important agriculture is to the state of Kentucky and cattle producers are a large reason for that. The nearly one million head of beef cattle in the Commonwealth and the more than 33,000 farms with beef cattle, solidifies cattle among one of Kentucky's top commodities.

As a cattle farmer myself, I know firsthand the hard work that goes into the beef industry from bottlefeeding calves to fighting the weather. It is that experience that forms my deep appreciation for the farmers across Kentucky who make this their passion year after year. Without their continued efforts Kentucky would not have the great agricultural community that makes it stand out amongst other states. Farming is the backbone of our state and cattle farmers are a large part of the equation.

Lastly, a lot of work goes into making this event possible every year. As always, I wish to thank Kentucky Venues CEO David Beck and his team for the many hours that went into hosting this event.

I don't know why but some cows just are not made to have heifer calves, and we've made two of them here in Finchville. The Jacksons bought the first one, MFF Comet, and we have Shelley. After hearing from Joe and Jim this fall that Comet finally had a heifer on her 8th calf, I was hoping Shelley would too but she had another bull. But that's not the calf we are selling, so let's talk about the older brother, Shell Shock. If you like them pretty, stout, and hairy, Shell Shocked is your man. If you study the pedigree, theres some similarities in the cow families. You'll see MB Shelby and MB Fancy Girl, full sisters that were sired by MB Lady out of MB Fran. Shelby and Fancy both were incredible show heifers as Shelby was the 2013 National Champion Female and Fancy was the 2014 Reserve National champion female in her only time in the show ring. Both Females have daughters that are National Champion Females and have sons that sired National Champion Females. Now if you look to the bulls in the pedigree you'll see some differences in type and kind but similarities in quality, Navigator and Bentley. Both National Champions almost 10 years apart but ones that have a lot of good to give, as seen here in Shell Shock. For several years all we sold were heifers sired by MFF Sheldon, Shell Shock's mother is the only full sister to Sheldon that we had. If you have made it this far and can't tell, I'll make it easy on you. I really, really like the pedigree this bull has behind him.

Rolls Royce was one that we didn't get to use as long as we wanted. He is one of my favorites we have raised and I admired his structure. In my opinion, he was one the best footed, best pasterned, best legged bulls I had seen since his sire, Bentley, was shown. He was so good about the angle to his shoulder, was so good about the way his neck tied into his shoulder, and was just one that moved with ease. I hoped that he passed his structural correctness onto his offspring and when you look at the 4 head we are bringing sired by him, while they are definitely not all perfect and there will be differences in them, I hope you see the extremely good angle to their shoulders, the way that they tie in at their neck/ shoulder junction, the angle and set to their rear legs, and the way they get out and travel. Today as im writing this, JORDAN M230 is my pick of the heifers. She a little more elegant about her front 1/3 and when parked has the advantage in a more correct rear leg. Jordans mother is the second oldest cow on the property, turning 13 and due with her 10th calf this spring. Jordan's granddam was bought out of this very sale in 2006 from Leo and Kyle and was the very first Red Poll female Dad ever purcahsed. Our other heifer lot is M231. Her mother is a full sister to the 2021 Champion Bred Heifer and the 2023 Champion Open Heifer here at the Ky Beef Expo Red Poll Sale and a maternal sister to our other heifer lot, JORDAN M230. Like her siblings in the sale, M231's angles are really good. She is larger framed and stouter made than our other heifer lot but one that still posses an elegant look. This is the last time that Rolls Royce offspring will be offered to the public so bid often and bid with confidence.

# Bylaw 38 – The Public Auction Sales Code

In the selling of registered Red Poll cattle, a complete statement of facts shall be made, along with all information on animal sold.

Sale Title - This shall be a definite statement of dispersal, partial dispersal or consignment, as the case may be, designating any cattle reserved.

- a) Dispersal Sale: Complete sell out, no salable cattle reserved. If a member of the firm or family wishes to purchase any animal to establish another herd, this fact should be stated in the catalog.
- b) Partial Dispersal: Selling part of the herd. Explanation must be made.
- c) Consignment Sale: Sale of animals consigned by different breeders. It is recommended that both consignor and breeder be listed on the pedigree of each animal in a consignment sale catalog.

#### **Terms & Conditions**

- 1. The highest bidder shall be the buyer.
- 2. The auctioneer selling will settle any dispute as to the bids by declaring all bids off and reselling the animal in question.
- 3. Cattle are property of purchasers as soon as sold by auctioneer, but will be cared for free of charge until delivered to buyer.
- 4. Terms of the sale are cash, unless other arrangements have been made with the owner before the sale.
- 5. Cattle are sold subject to health regulations of any state or country.
- 6. Breeding dates for animals that have been bred and not listed in the catalog will be given sale day.
- 7. If errors are noted in the catalog, announcements will take precedence over the matter in the catalog.
- 8. Each animal is recorded, or will be recorded in the Herd Books of the American Red Poll Association. Certificates of registry and transfer will be recorded by the seller and furnished the purchaser free of charge.
- 9. Owner warrants clear title to the property and right to sell the same.
- 10. Unless otherwise noted in a catalog or announced from the auction stand, each animal is sold as sound.



- 1. The breeding guarantee shall constitute a contract between the seller and buyer of each animal sold at public or private sale, except for that in the case of complete Dispersal Sales, the seller may choose between selling and not selling under the Breeding Guarantee.
- 2. Proper care must be given by the purchaser to protect breeding qualities and health of guaranteed animals.
- 3. Bulls sold as separate lots are guaranteed breeders.
  - a. Provided:
    - (1) They are not allowed to serve until 14 months of age.
    - (2) Or allowed to run with the herd until 20 months of age.
    - (3) Notice of failure to settle cows is given within 6 months of purchase or 6 months after bull becomes serviceable age.
  - b. Bull calves under 8 months of age sold at sides of dams are not guaranteed breeders.

#### 4. Guarantee of Females

- a. All females over 14 months of age, sold open, are guaranteed open and breeders.
  - (1) If not settled in 6 months, they shall be reported to seller.
  - (2) Heifers under 14 months of age are to be open, and, if in calf, shall be reported promptly to the seller.
- b. Females sold as bred animals, but not in calf, must be reported to seller within 3 months of sale date.
- c. Females bred within less than 8 months prior to date of sale are not guaranteed to be in calf but are guaranteed breeders.
- d. Heifers under 8 months of age are not guaranteed breeders if sold at sides of dams.

#### 5. Adjustments

- Seller may replace animal in question, with another of equal value, at time of purchase to the satisfaction of the buyer, OR
- b. Seller may refund purchase price. No interest, feed, transportation or fees to be charged to seller. Salvage goes to seller.
- c. Seller may elect retrial period, not to exceed 6 months.
  - (1) Transportation to be paid by seller.
  - (2) If animal proves to be a breeder, it shall be returned to purchaser at the expense of purchaser.
  - (3) No feed, fees or maintenance charge will be made by either buyer or seller.
